



Reporting Rabies Post-Exposure Prophylaxis, 2015

New Jersey health care providers are required to report all administrations of rabies post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) to the local health department where the patient resides. Health officers are requested to forward copies of the completed report forms to the New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH), Communicable Disease Service (CDS).

To assist local health departments with collection of these data, the PEP reporting form (CDC-2) has been updated to recognize the currently recommended 4 vaccine dose PEP protocol and is posted on the NJDOH website: <http://www.state.nj.us/health/cd/forms.shtml>. Health Officers receiving the CDC-2 forms from health care providers are requested to either fax or mail the form to the NJDOH, CDS.
