



- MSNJ's survey of OMNIA Tier 2 physicians found significant loss of revenue and interruption in patient care.
- MSNJ is working with outside counsel to evaluate potential legal causes of action that could be brought by Tier 2 physicians against Horizon.
- Nationally renowned healthcare lawyers from the Whatley Kallas law firm will speak to members about potential theories of liability.
- Whatley Kallas was involved in the national class-action lawsuits against all the major carriers for unfair business practices. They negotiated the settlement of the national class-action with most of the Blues in the country, including Horizon.
- The firm is currently lead counsel for doctors and other providers in an antitrust case against the Blue Cross Blue Shield Association and all Blues, including Horizon.
