CONGRESS'S BIPARTISAN OPIOID CRISIS RESPONSE BILL

SUPPORT for Patients and Communities Act: A massive overhaul of government action against the opioid epidemic. STATUS: Passed Senate 98-1, Passed House 393-8, Awaiting Presidential Approval.



WHAT DOES IT DO?

- Instate "Comprehensive Opioid Recovery Centers"
- Un-restrict opioid addiction medications
- Improve Medicare/Medicaid to limit overprescription of opioid painkillers
- Penalize overprescription of opioids
- Improves border control of illicit drug running

WHAT DOES IT NOT DO?

- Not enough focus on addiction treatment expansion
- No significant increase in funding--\$8 billion over 5 years
- Opioid companies not held financially accountable for role in opioid epidemic
