

## **2013 MEDICAL LICENSE RENEWAL**

### **Why am I being asked to complete a workforce survey as part of my 2013 medical license renewal?**

The workforce survey was part of pending legislation that would have required physicians to complete it. Governor Christie vetoed the legislation and participation in the workforce survey is now voluntary.

### **Must I complete the workforce survey that is included in the 2013 medical license renewal?**

Participation in the workforce survey is voluntary. MSNJ is urging our members and all physicians in the state to participate in the voluntary workforce survey, which is included in the license renewal. The information will assist the state in its evaluation of physician demographics and access to care.

### **How do I opt out of the survey?**

If desired, physicians may opt out of the survey by clicking “save and finish later” on the workforce survey page. MSNJ asks that members complete the survey.

### **When is my medical license renewal application due?**

Applications are due on or before July 15, 2013.

### **May I delegate the completion of my license renewal application to my staff?**

The physician should complete the renewal and survey, as he/she must attest that all information is correct and true at the end of the application.

### **How can I get assistance if I need help completing the survey?**
